Dear New York REALTOR®,

**Please be advised that we have additional updates to the information on Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA). Below are two additional questions that were presented by our members. These questions will be added to the Pandemic Unemployment Assistance Frequently Asked Questions section on [nysarcovidupdates.com](http://www.nysarcovidupdates.com).**

Please remember that the process to apply for PUA is extremely fluid, however, and we will update this memorandum as additional guidance is made available.

***Q - Where a husband and wife or other partnership team books sales and commissions to their LLC., can one spouse or partner apply for PUA benefits?***

A - Self-employed individuals can apply for PUA benefits. Each spouse or partner can apply for unemployment insurance benefits. Once denied, the individuals will then be able to apply for PUA. This flowchart provides information on the required steps

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***Q - Individuals who are receiving partial PUA payments will also be eligible to receive an additional \$600 per week benefit through July 31, 2020, pursuant to the Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (“PUC”). Do you also receive the additional \$600/week if you receive full PUA payments?***

A - Yes, individuals who are eligible for PUA payments will also receive the additional \$600 PUC payment.
